



Greetings friends, family, and Kingdom partners,

We, Trevor and Adina Kring, pastors of Kingdom Culture Community Church in Tucson, Arizona, are writing to give you an update on our church and provide you with an opportunity to partner with us. It is our mission to love God, love others, and make disciples. It certainly has been an amazing journey!

Our church was planted in 2017 in the living room of our average sized home with a few friends and our dog. People's lives were being touched by God. We have seen many give their lives to Jesus, get baptized, and equipped for service. We have seen God heal people physically, spiritually, and relationally. He has restored many lives, marriages, and families at our church. As a result, we grew until there was over 100 people in our house with barely enough room to stand.



In 2019, we began renting space from a local church, Abounding Grace. After some remodeling, we began to have services on that campus in early 2020. We were all set for our big community outreach grand opening, but COVID. The year 2020 brought many challenges, but God. He helped us navigate every difficulty, and in a year where so many churches closed, we were blessed and even grew. As the wave of the pandemic subsided, we began public services again. To date, our children's ministry keeps growing, we regularly connect with new families. We see the power of God move as we set our face and hearts to follow Jesus in building His Kingdom. We have also been able to partner with foreign missions' ministries in Cuba, Mexico, and Africa. God is truly blessing our community.

Our lease is up at the end of April 2023. Abounding Grace has decided to sell the property, which has been appraised at \$1.6 million. This is truly a Red Sea moment for our church. We know God has brought us here and blessed us here, but on our own, the purchase of this property is not possible. I thank God that we are not, however, on our own. God is with us in this valley, and we are not afraid. There is, however, much to be done. We have budgeted, saved, and stewarded our resources. We are now giving our loaves and fishes to Jesus and are trusting that our Father will help us feed and house His children.

At this time, we would like to extend an opportunity for you to partner with us in what God is doing in our church. You can partner with us in two ways: prayer and provision.

- **Prayer** – Please pray for us as we navigate this challenge. We rely upon God’s wisdom and discernment to know God’s will and timing for every decision we make. We are asking His Holy Spirit to bring down obstacles and to make a way where there seems to be no way.
- **Provision** – We invite you to partner with us financially. To secure this property, we will need a down payment for the loan and capital upfront for repairs. Your gift is tax deductible and 100% of it will go directly toward the purchase of the campus of Abounding Grace. By giving, you are not just facilitating the purchase of this property, you are advancing the Kingdom and becoming a crucial part of what God is doing in our church and our city.

Staying on this campus will support the growth and development of our children’s ministries, discipleship tracks, and evangelism programs. It will also allow us to expand our outreach and foreign missions’ initiatives, to train and equip leaders and future church planters, and so much more.
